MILWAUKEE BALLET'S CURRENT NUTCRACKER ON STAGE FOR THE FINAL TIME

- The holiday favorite starts December 10, for the final run before a new production opens in 2023 -

Milwaukee, **WI** – **November 17**, **2022** – Milwaukee Ballet's holiday favorite, *The Nutcracker*, returns this December for the 25th and final year of the current production. An annual tradition for generations of families, the magical extravaganza will come to life once again December 10-24, 2022, at Marcus Performing Arts Center's Uihlein Hall.

The city's largest winter holiday spectacle features a cast of nearly 150 dancers, including students from Milwaukee Ballet School & Academy, who join the professional dancers of Milwaukee Ballet Company and the Milwaukee Ballet II Second Company. Tchaikovsky's festive score is performed live by the Milwaukee Ballet Orchestra under the direction of Associate Conductor Pasquale Laurino.

"During my 20 years in Milwaukee, I have seen how much *The Nutcracker* means to our community with families and friends returning year after year," said Artistic Director Michael Pink. "This year will be extraordinarily special as we say farewell and perform the current production for the last time."

The Nutcracker has been performed in Milwaukee for decades and the appeal of this magical story has never waned, continuing to attract new audiences each year. However, after 25 years, the current Milwaukee Ballet production has outlived its usable life, with costumes and sets beyond continued maintenance. This provides the organization with an exciting opportunity to breathe new life into the timeless classic. Earlier this month, Pink unveiled plans for a reimagined, all-new production scheduled to debut in December 2023.

The new *Nutcracker* will retain much of the traditional story and characters that people have come to know and love. However, Pink will reimagine the overall production and infuse it with new magic and creativity. All sets, costumes, and props in the production will be new—from the elaborate ballgowns to feathered hairclips, from the mechanical props to the wooden nutcracker doll. Refreshed choreography and a revamped cast of characters will bring new life and energy to the stage next year.

"Conceiving of, and producing, a new *Nutcracker* is perhaps one of the most exciting opportunities for any classical ballet company," said Pink. "We recognize the decades of memories and will take care to preserve the tradition for many generations to come."

Pink has brought together an award-winning design team to bring his vision to life. Set designer Todd Edward Ivins, an Associate Artist for Milwaukee Repertory Theater, has worked with Pink on numerous ballets and musicals. Costumes are being designed by Emmy-nominated designer Gregory A. Poplyk, whose most recent

work has been featured in the HBO series *The Gilded Age*. Emmy Award-winning lighting designer David Grill, continues his longtime collaboration with Pink and Milwaukee Ballet, and the creative talents of Chicago based VonOrthal Puppets will round out our design team.

Milwaukee Ballet is currently in the midst of a \$5 million New *Nutcracker* Capital Campaign to support the design and build of new sets and costumes, establish a preservation fund to ensure ongoing maintenance of all elements of the production, and support expanded community engagement initiatives related to this project with the Give Back to MKE fund.
