



In July, Milwaukee Ballet initiated a new program, Ballet Beat. Company members provided three weeks of free activities and performances as a thank you to the Milwaukee community for its sustaining support. Ballet Beat allowed us to engage with thousands of people during the summer—our city's most vibrant time—and we are looking forward to repeating this program in summer 2018.

Milwaukee Ballet continues to be a fiscally sustainable organization. We are grateful for the contributions from our generous individual, foundation and corporate donors, locally and nationally. This year, almost 90% of the company's resources were allocated in support of Milwaukee Ballet's programs and services, and we finished FY17 with a positive bottom line before depreciation.






